These presentations spread knowledge, cultivate curiosity, and engender additional collaborations among the broader research community, in addition to developing students' public speaking skills and encouraging a healthy competitive spirit amongst participants.

CONFERENCE LOGISTICS: - Abstract deadline for both oral and poster presentations is August 12th, 2024 at 11:59 PM. Late abstracts accepted until September 6th; late abstracts will be ineligible for podium presentations and judging. For posters to be judged a pdf must be uploaded to the UBEC website by August 26th at 11:59 PM.

- For posters to be judged and eligible for a monetary reward a pdf of the poster must be uploaded by August 26th at 11:59 PM on https://ubec.bme.utah.edu/abstract/
- All abstracts will be published

- Monetary awards will be presented to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place presenters in both the poster and oral presentation categories at the close of the conference **ABSTRACT**

SUBMISSION INFORMATION:

 Abstracts must contain:
- Abstract Title (100 character maximum)
- Presenting Author and Co-Author(s)
- Author's Institution(s) and Department(s)
- Maximum of 500 words
- The following labeled sections: Introduction, Methods, Results, and Discussion

Abstracts will be reviewed and selected according to the following criteria:

- 1) Scientific merit and novelty of the research
- 2) Presence of sufficient experimental data to support the conclusion
- 3) Relevance to the field of biomedical engineering
- 4) Overall clarity and quality of the technical writing

GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRESENTERS:

- Poster dimensions must not exceed 48" by 48"
- All posters must be set up by 11:00AM on the day of the conference.

- Presenters must be present at their poster during their poster session.
- Research may have been previously presented at a regional, national, or international conference.

GUIDELINES FOR ORAL PRESENTERS:

- Each presenter selected for an oral presentation will be given a 12 minute time slot. 10 minutes will be allotted for their presentation, while 2 minutes will be allotted for Q&A with the audience.
- Final slides must be submitted by Thursday, September 19th at 11:59 PM. Additional details will be provided to presenters upon abstract acceptance.
- All presentations will be recorded.
- Presenters may optionally release recordings for inclusion in UBEC archives and social media posts. Requires Media Release Form provided upon abstract acceptance.
